## **Continued supply of medicines and medical devices in all markets, independent of the Brexit outcome**

As Baxter is a major supplier of medicines and medical devices globally and in Europe, and has a strong manufacturing presence in Europe, Baxter is well prepared to handle also a “No-Deal” Brexit. As you are aware, the legislation governing different product groups and the potential impact of a ‘No-Deal’ Brexit differs depending upon the product, where it is manufactured, and the market in question.

CE certificates for all Baxter medical devices that could be impacted by a “No-Deal” Brexit, have already been transferred from the BSI UK to EU Notified Bodies as BSI Netherlands or TÜV in Germany. Labelling on our products will now be updated in the next 2 years to reflect the new Notified Body details.

Furthermore, all our medicinal product Reference State roles have been transferred from the MHRA in the UK to other Medicines Authorities in the EU.

We are also ready with Product Release procedures for UK products manufactured for the EU, to update Product Registrations and mitigate stock levels in various locations in Europe.
